## **MATTERS ARISING AT MEETING**

### **1. Future Speakers at General Meetings-**

The committee is looking at a sub-committee being organised to and having them arrange our society's participation in the Macquarie University astronomy open night. Noel Sharpe has offered to be the coordinator of the sub-committee.

**7. Library Report-**

Phillip Ainsworth proposed that the society order a copy of Dr Ragbir Bhathal's "Australian Astronomers" book.

**8. Christmas Party and Awards Night-**

It has been proposed that the society have an awards night and possible Christmas party in December. This would include awards recognising different persons' efforts in the society this year. In particular an award would be presented to the person or persons who have achieved a great amount during the year.

**9. M.A.S. Young Astronomers' Group-**

It has been proposed that a Macarthur Astronomical Society young astronomers' group be formed with regular meetings on certain weekday afternoons, including possible talks given by older society members. This has been proposed because of interest expressed by local school students. Meetings would most likely be held at St. Andrews High School.

**10. Astronomy Camp-**

It has been proposed that the society hold an astronomy camp for members, possibly in November. Plenty of telescopes and binoculars are a must. The camp would be held at somewhere like Hill End or Kangaroo Valley.
