Members are invited to submit articles for public reading on the MAS website. I don't want to set too many rules but the article must be your own work and the content must be of an appropriate nature. To date we have accepted mostly astronomy articles but have also permitted some science fiction.

Creating & Formatting

Create your article using the word processor of your choice. Include your name and date below the title as author of the article and consider embedding images & tables to break up the text and present the article more attractively to potential readers.

Copyright and Attribution

Copyright of the article belongs to the author, who by uploading, grants MAS permission to publish the work. Your articles may remain published after your MAS membership ends, unless you direct us otherwise.

Submission Checklist:

- title
- name and date
- proof read
- spelling
- consistent font type and formatting
- attribution of images and quotations
- overall appearance
