Online conference meeting Monday 5th June 2023 at 7.00 pm

1 OPENING OF MEETING

The Zoom meeting opened at 7.03 pm.

2 MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

2.1 ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES DATED 17th MAY 2023

Motion: That the Minutes dated 17th May 2023, as circulated and posted, be accepted.

3.1.2 Term Deposit

Comm Bank offers 3.25% p.a. for 6 months and 3.95% for for 12 months. The Committee agreed:

- to terminate the existing monthly rolling 1% term deposit on maturity (24th June);
- to arrange a new term deposit of 12 months duration at 3.95% or thereabouts;
- that the amount to be deposited will be \$25,000 or thereabouts;
- the arrangements to be made prior to 24th June by JR and AM at Commonwealth Bank.

3.2.1 Report

There have been no new memberships since the previous meeting. The Membership register submitted by Dave Manning (MO) showed a current membership of 138.

JR received an invitation for MAS to attend a Science Day fair at Mt Annan, from 10.00am - 3.00pm on the forecourt and surrounds of the new National Herbarium of NSW. This would mean setting up our marquee, with information, a couple of scopes and maybe our solar scope.

3.11.6 Scouts: November

An approach has been made for us to show the night sky at a location to be determined in the Southern Highlands sometime in November.

3.12 RETURN & EARN

GB:The MAS account has been moved from PayPal to direct Bank Transfer. Return and Earn classifies MAS as a charity. We are currently a preferred beneficiary at various locations until the end of October.

3.13 LOAN TELESCOPES

GB: all loan telescopes are available for loan or for use at the Beginners Workshop.

The 8" f/6 Dobsonian telescope which was donated to the Society by Jenny and Greg Blackburn will be used as a future loan telescope. MacDob will probably be retired.

3.15 MATTERS ARISING FROM AGM AND ANNUAL REPORT

3.15.1 Constitution

RP: DOFT approval was sought on 19th April, with no response yet. RP has written to DOFT to seek urgent approval.

Should there be no response received within eight weeks of submission, 19th June 2023, RP proposed that MAS formally deems that the constitution has been approved by DOFT, adopts a commencement date of 13th June 2023 and DOFT to be informed accordingly. Agreed.

3.15.2 Fund-raising

AM warned in his Annual Treasurer's Report "that it would be necessary to provide substantial funding beyond membership fees to match the expected expenditure."

AM was requested to provide a forward financial projection for the end of 2023-24 to evaluate if there is still a financial problem. It was noted that additional income from a term deposit might assist.

3.16 PAYPAL ALTERNATIVES

It was agreed that, whilst retaining PayPal, members need to be steered towards using Direct Bank Transfer to pay membership fees. RP to amend website. GB to amend new members application form.
