RP: For Zoom viewers, there are sound quality variations when a speaker does not stand close to the microphone or moves around and sometimes faces away from the microphone. With a guest speaker who powerfully projects their voice, the quality variations were mostly minimal but were still detectable. We can expect quality issues with other guest speakers who do not remain within the optimal range of the microphone.

GB: advised that the only microphone being used is integrated with the webcam, two or three meters from the lectern. He will investigate if the microphone can be moved closer and we may also consider asking the speaker to remain at a constant close distance to it.
